We welcome the Government of Honduras' participation in the Open Government Partnership (OGP), which now comprises 79 countries and 76 local governments working to implement open government commitments to promote greater transparency, accountability and citizen engagement in policy making.

We acknowledge the letter from the Technical Committee of the Open Government Partnership in Honduras, that requested to be shifted to the even-year cohort of OGP participants due to the electoral process taking place.

As a result, Honduras has been shifted from the "odd year" to the "even year" cohort of OGP participants, and considered to have started a new action plan cycle with a deadline of 31 August 2022 to submit its action plan. This letter is to kindly remind you that failure to deliver the action plan by this new deadline would result in Honduras having acted contrary to OGP process for two consecutive cycles, and therefore would be placed under review by the Criteria and Standards Subcommittee.
